

BAY COUNTY PARENTING TIME POLICY  
SCHEDULE C

In a family where the oldest child has completed kindergarten, all younger children are bound by this schedule. This schedule shall be followed unless otherwise mutually agreed upon in writing, signed by both parties and submitted to the Friend of the Court office.

Regular Parenting Time

1. Each parent shall have alternating weekends from 6 p.m. on Friday until 6 p.m. on Sunday.
2. The non-custodial parent shall have one evening each week for a minimum of two (2) hours, for example on Wednesday from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m.; Work schedules may require a different day and/or time period.

Periods of Extended Parenting Time

1. Summer Vacation.

Alternating weeks of parenting time from 6 p.m. Friday until 6 p.m. the following Friday.

Summer parenting time shall begin on the first Friday after school recesses; beginning with the parent who would normally have parenting time on that weekend. Summer parenting time shall conclude on the Friday immediately preceding the next school year beginning.

The alternating weekend schedule shall remain in effect throughout the entire year without exception. The mid-week parenting time schedule is suspended during the extended summer parenting time schedule.

Based on the alternating week parenting time schedule, the child(ren) shall remain with that parent exercising parenting time for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July holiday, until the regular scheduled exchange time.

2. Christmas School Vacation.

In the odd-numbered years, the father shall have the Christmas school vacation. In the even-numbered years, the mother shall have the Christmas school vacation.

Christmas school vacation is defined as 6 p.m. the day school recesses until 6 p.m. the day before school resumes. The alternating weekend schedule remains in effect. The mid-week parenting time schedule is suspended during the extended Christmas school vacation parenting time schedule.

3. Spring School Break.

In the even-numbered years the mother shall have the spring school break. In the odd-numbered years the father shall have the spring school break.

Spring school break is defined as 6 p.m. the day school recesses until 6 p.m. the day before school resumes. The alternating weekend schedule remains in effect. The mid-week parenting time schedule is suspended during the extended Spring school break parenting time schedule.

Miscellaneous Information

1. The alternating weekend parenting time schedule is to be exercised throughout the entire calendar year. Only by written mutual agreement signed by the parents and submitted to the Friend of the Court office shall the weekend rotation be changed.
2. During any period of extended parenting time, the holiday schedule continues as specified.
3. Summer school necessary for the child(ren) to pass to the next grade must be attended.
4. A general itinerary and emergency telephone number shall be provided to the other parent if an out-of-town vacation is planned.
5. The parenting time schedule will be exercised in a prompt manner. In the event of an unforeseen circumstance, a 30-minute delay is allowed for picking up and returning the child(ren).
6. During periods of extended parenting time with the non-custodial parent, the child support abatement shall not be affected by regularly scheduled parenting time periods with the custodial parent. For example, during extended summer parenting time, weekend parenting time with the custodial parent shall not affect the abatement.
7. Transportation for parenting time shall be shared equally between the parties. The parent receiving the child(ren) shall be responsible for picking up the child(ren) from the other parent's residence.
8. Holiday parenting time according to the attached Bay County Holiday Parenting Policy.
