^{*} Flu vaccines will be provided throughout the lunch hour.

The CDC recommends that everyone six months of age and older receive the flu vaccine.

- Flu is a respiratory infection that peaks between October and March. The vaccine provides protection that will last throughout the entire Flu season.
- Some people, such as young children, pregnant women and older adults, especially those with certain health conditions are at high risk for complications from the Flu.
- The 2017-2018 Flu vaccine will protect you from 4 Flu strains that are circulating this year.

WHAT TO BRING: All medical health insurance cards including Medicare, Medicaid, & private insurance, and a driver's license or Michigan ID. **If you do not have health insurance, the cost of the vaccine is \$25.00.** Cost may be determined based on income.
